

The House at Pooh Corner

Stage Crew Application

This year's middle school production is **The House at Pooh Corner**. Always a highlight of the school year, the spring play provides many opportunities for students to be involved either on stage or behind the scenes.

Guidelines:

- **Considerations about the commitment.** Being in the play is a commitment that will consume a considerable amount of time. If academics or family life will be adversely affected by that sacrifice of time, participation in the play should be avoided. Academic expectations remain the same for students who are in the play.
- **Be on time.** To make each rehearsal as productive as possible, complete cooperation from each crew member is essential. Only four young men will be selected to be part of the stage crew
- **Rehearsal schedule.** All rehearsals are required except for cases of illness or family emergency. If a student must miss a rehearsal, the parent or student should send the stage director an email or note in advance of rehearsal time explaining the situation. Activities such as school sports, birthday parties or other purely recreational activities are not grounds to miss rehearsals. During the final two weeks of rehearsal, students should not miss for any reason. Carefully look over the rehearsal schedule.
- **Crew expectations.** Crew members should understand that being in the play is a special privilege that can be forfeited by failure to abide by play policies. Those in the crew are expected to maintain an excellent discipline and academic record. The stage crew will prepare the scenery and props for the play and will help during each performance. The stage crew is in charge of the lights, sound effects, moving scenery and handling props backstage.
- **Late Stay availability.** Students not picked up when rehearsal is over will be checked into late stay. Regular late stay charges will apply, including the rate of \$12 per 15 minutes after 5:30 p.m.
